## FROM TRIBE LEAGUE TO ALUMNI PRESIDENT

When I joined the Neighborhood Boys Club in 1964, I understood that I had to bring my whole team with me. The Tarantulas were just beyond the NBC boundaries and to start another age group I would need enough for a baseball team. There were already older Tarantulas that included my brother **Jim, Phil Cline, Rory Wagner, Ken Rockwell** and others nearer to St. Andrew. New guys outside the boundaries would not be placed on another team. So I got a few friends who got a few more and we signed up together. We were placed in the White division of the Tribe League and we won the championship. I still have that medal. I probably had the worst average on the team, but I do know that I actually got a homer that summer. That meant that an outfielder was sleeping on the job and the ground was probably hard like cement. The ball may have picked up speed as it rolled down hill toward field 1 or 2. It was a good year.

By the following year I was a Leader candidate. After a number of years as a Leader, **Dick Valentin** asked **Jim Kartheiser** and myself to join the staff in the summer of 1969. When I left the Club at the end of 1974, I did not know I would be invited back by **Mr. Buehler** the following year to be executive director.
