You can register at the Meet! Our Track Meet will again be held at California Park tomorrow, Sunday, May 17th. The jumping events will begin at 1:00 p.m. and the running events start at 2:00 p.m.

More than 200 members will be in attendance striving to achieve a track victory! The winner of each heat will receive a heat ribbon, and there will be first, second, and third place ribbons for the final heats. Those who accumulate 10 or more tallies will earn a Track Trophy!

The jumps are the Triple Broad Jump, Running Jump, and the High Jump. The running events include the 50, 75, 100, and 220 yard dashes, the 50 yard backward run, the mile and half mile runs, and team relay races! All boys are encouraged to come out and try! All heats will be determined by the abilities of the runners so that everyone has a better chance.

NBC Dad, Alumni, and Friends will serve as official judges, timers, and co-ordinators. The Leaders and Staff will be on hand for the set up, organization, and clean up. The Neighborhood Boys Club celebrated its 50th Anniversary on Saturday, May 2nd, in grand fashion! Members of the two teams were in attendance! In one corner of the hall, there was a continuous slide show that brought back the memories of the early Thanksgiving Day Classics, Track Meets, Baseball championships, and trips to Galena. The opening act was quite impressive!

The Reverend George Klein, principal of St. Benedict High School, gave the invocation. After a succulent roast beef dinner, the main program began, Toastmaster Jack Brickhouse of WGN, a longtime friend of NBC's, introduced the President of Loyola University, Rev. Ray Baumhart. He set the mood for the rest of the evening with an inspirational speech. The entertaining George Gobel, a former member, had everyone laughing!

The highlight had to be the speech by our Founder, Mr. Robert Buehler, and his presentation to Mr. Richard Valentin. Mr. Valentin was a guiding force behind the development of the NBC Program during his 45 years as Director. For the past 5 years, he has remained active in the Alumni Association and on the Board of Directors.

After the speeches, the music began and the dance floor quickly filled. The merriment continued until early Sunday morning! The Banquet demonstrated what the Boys Club is about.

The hard work of those who were responsible for this event should not go unmentioned. Mr. James Baumhart, the Banquet Chairman, spent countless hours organizing and planning the evening, as did Alumni President Herb Preiner and Dick Valentin.
